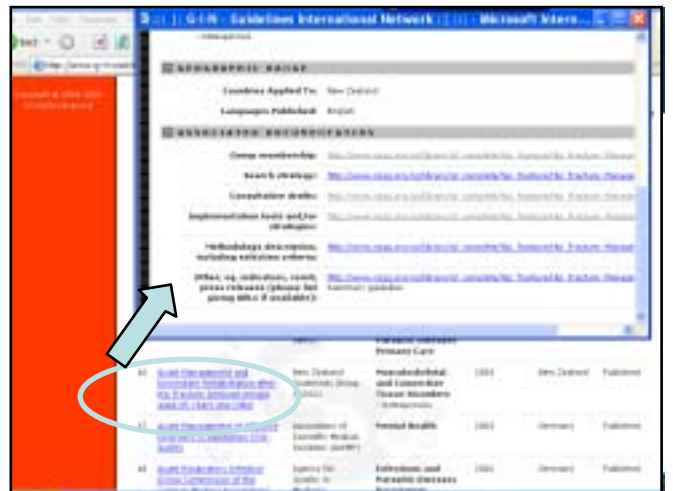


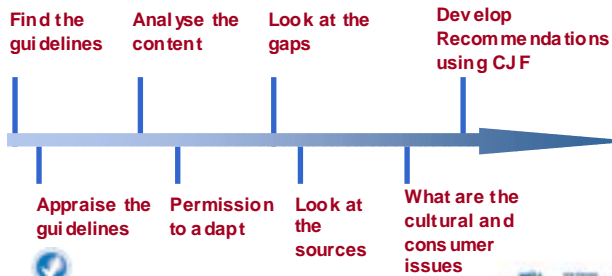


# NZGG's views

- There is considerable ambiguity in the written guideline recommendations - so translation to electronic formats needs to have a rigorous validation process around it
- Guideline developers are looking for ways to produce evidence and guidelines faster, smarter and at less cost
- Greater reliance on sharing evidence between countries and shared updating of guidelines
- Decisions on a markup format need to take account of international initiatives
